**Role Title:** Education and family learning volunteers

**Responsible to:** Access and Education Officer (AEO) – Frances Bray

- Awareness of DDA and follow guidelines given in BTM info sheet.
- Follow guidelines and training in Child Protection.

**Skills required:**

- Friendly and welcoming personality.
- An interest in and enthusiasm for working with young people and children.
- Good communication skills.
- Patient and understanding nature.

**Hours:**

- Ideally volunteers would be able to commit to one or two days each week on a rota basis, but can be flexible.
