Role Title: Costumed guides and story teller volunteers

Responsible to: Access and Education Officer (AEO) – Frances Bray

Purpose: To help interpret the building and collection to visitors

Responsibilities:

- To help interpret the building and exhibits to a variety of visitors e.g. family groups, railway enthusiasts, visitors with access requirements.
- Compliance with BTM's Health & Safety policy and, where appropriate implementing emergency and accident procedures.
- Awareness of DDA and follow guidelines given in BTM info sheet.
- Follow guidelines and training in Child Protection.

Skills required:

- Friendly and welcoming personality and ability to interact with the public.
- An interest in acting or drama.
- Good communication skills.
- Patient and understanding nature.

Hours:

- Ideally volunteers would be able to commit to ½ a day each week on a rota basis.

- Passing on knowledge and enthusiasm for Bury's local history to visitors.
